NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

Format: 54 holes of stroke play competition

Tees: Play will be from the GOLD tee markers

Tie Breaking Procedures: In the event of a tie, a winner will be determined by hole by hole playoff starting on Hole #18. If more than one hole is required for a winner to be determined, the following sequence of holes shall be used: 10,18,10,18 etc.

Play is governed by the 2016 Golf Canada Rules of Golf and its 2016-2017 Decisions, and by the following RBC Cordova Bay Invitational Supplementary Local Rules, subject to change up to the start of the Tournament. Unless otherwise provided, the penalty for breach of a local rule is two strokes. Rules on the local (club) scorecard, posted on notice boards or posted on the course do not apply.

Specification of the ball and clubs: Only golf balls and golf clubs that have been tested on apparatus approved by Golf Canada and found to conform to the current Golf Canada list may be used. The current List of Conforming Golf Balls is available on the Golf Canada website. Penalty for Breach of Condition: Disqualification

Pace of Play: See the 2017 RBC Cordova Bay Invitational Pace of Play Policy. The pace of play for this tournament is 4 hours 15 minutes.

Discontinuance of Play: When play is suspended because of a potentially dangerous situation, a player must discontinue play immediately. Penalty for Breach of Condition: Disqualification All practice areas are closed when play is suspended for a dangerous situation until the Tournament Committee has declared them open. A suspension for a dangerous situation will be signaled by a single long blast from an air horn. Resumption of play will be signaled by an intermittent horn indicating it is safe to resume your position on the golf course.

Practice: Prior to and following play of a stipulated round, a player may practice only in the designated practice areas. During play of a stipulated round, a player may not practice on or near the putting green of the hole last played or roll a ball on the putting green of the hole last played.

Designated Practice Areas: The driving range, the practice putting green and the chipping area on the putting green side of the split rail fence, the practice bunker including the area 30 feet around its circumference, and the entire Ridge Course. NOTE: Players are not to hit balls over the back fence (260 yards to base) of the driving range. Penalty for Breach of Condition: Disqualification

Transportation: Players must not ride on any form of transportation during a stipulated round unless authorized by the Tournament Committee. Exception: a Rules Official may provide transportation for a player who must return to the tee or to the point where the previous stroke was made and to assist a player to catch up with play as the Rules Official deems appropriate. Penalty for Breach of Condition: See Penalty Statement in Appendix 1, Part B, Section 8.

Scorecards: Must be returned to the Scorer's Area immediately upon completion of play of the final hole of the stipulated round. Penalty for Breach of Condition: Disqualification

Close of Competition: The competition is deemed to have closed when the trophy has been presented to the Winner.
